



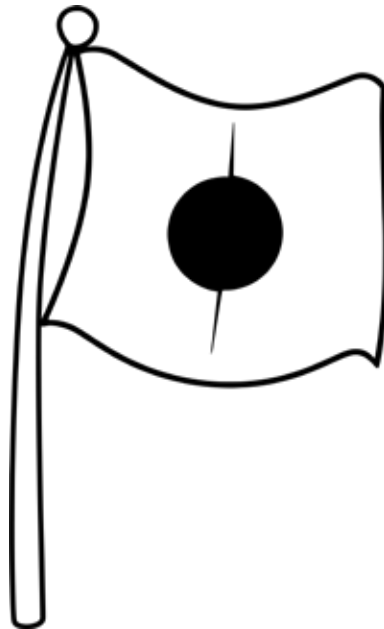

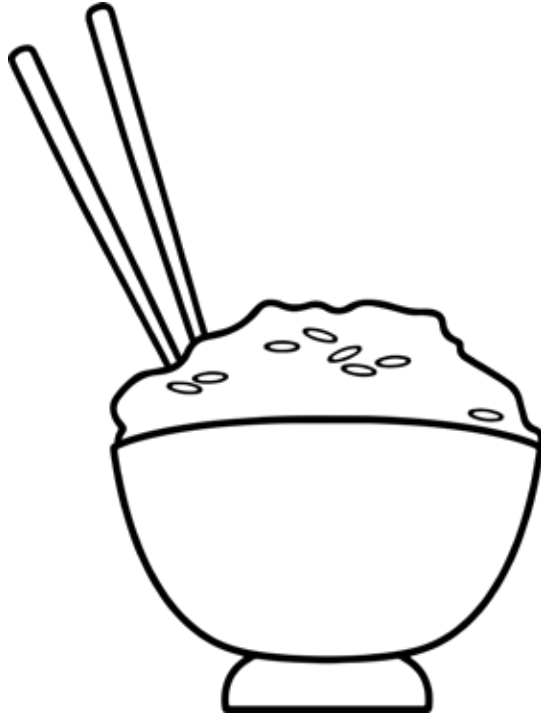
Japan is an island country on the Asian continent.

The Japanese flag, known as Hinomaru or Nisshōki, features a white background with a centered red circle



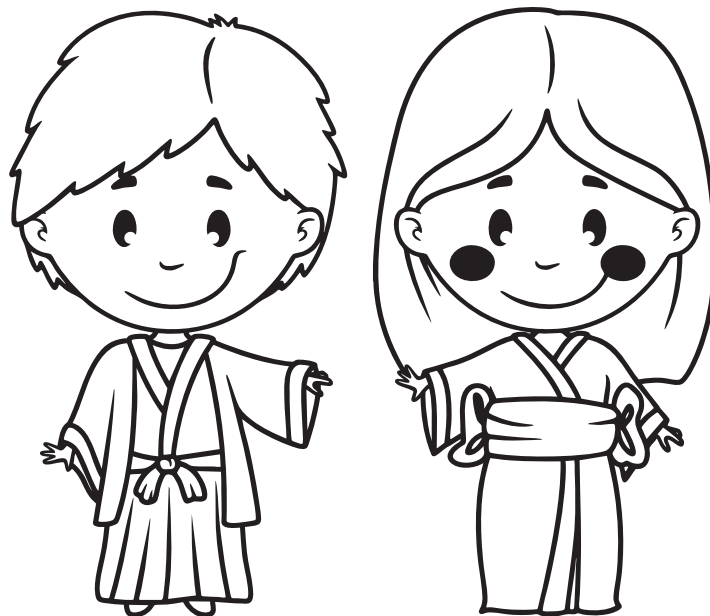
Japanese diet consists mainly of rice, fish, soy products and vegetables.



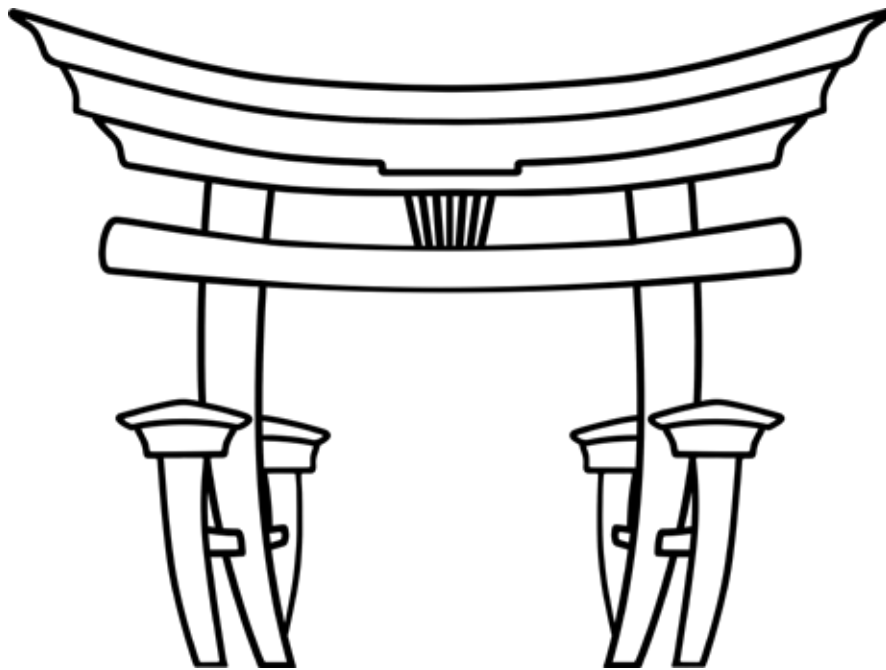
Japan is renowned for its picturesque cherry blossoms, or "sakura," which bloom every spring.
