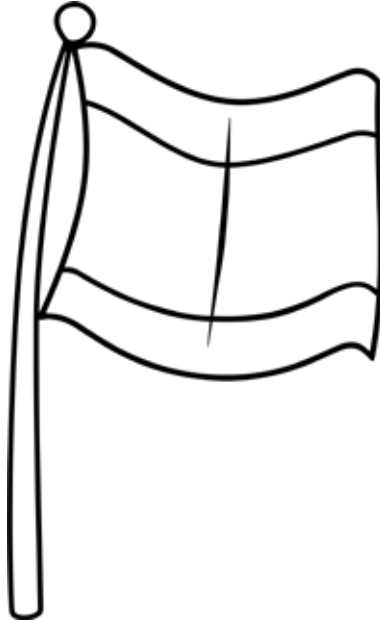

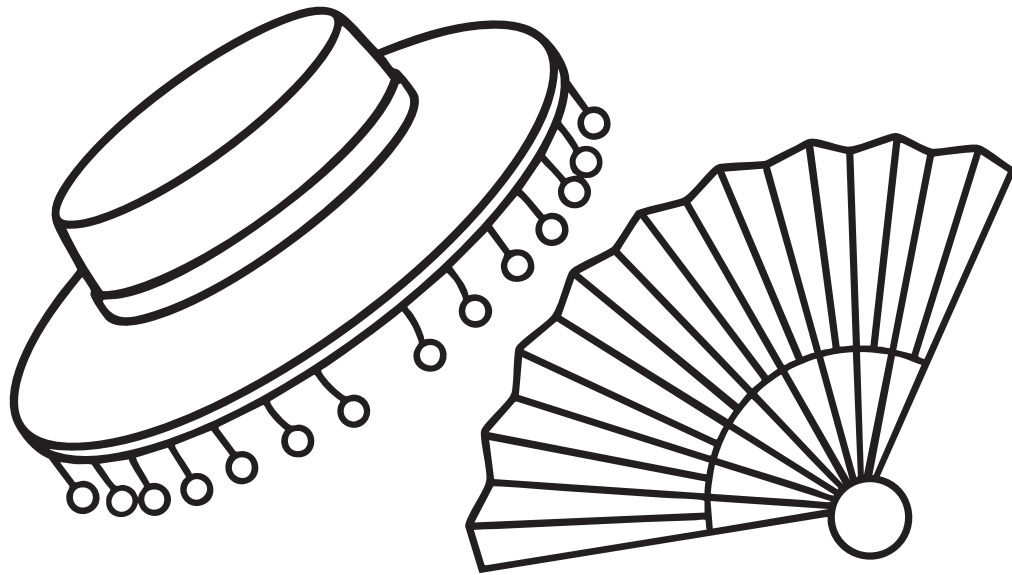
Spain occupies most of Europe's Iberian Peninsula.

Spain has a rich cultural heritage, including flamenco dancing, a passionate dance form with music and clapping.



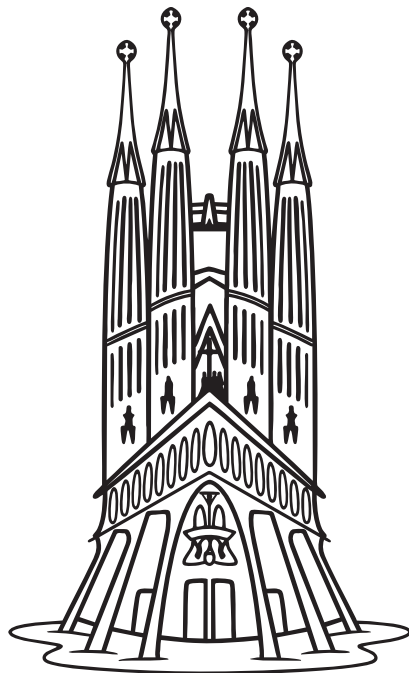
Spain is also known for many festivals, such as the 'Tomatina' that attract thousands of participants and visitors.
