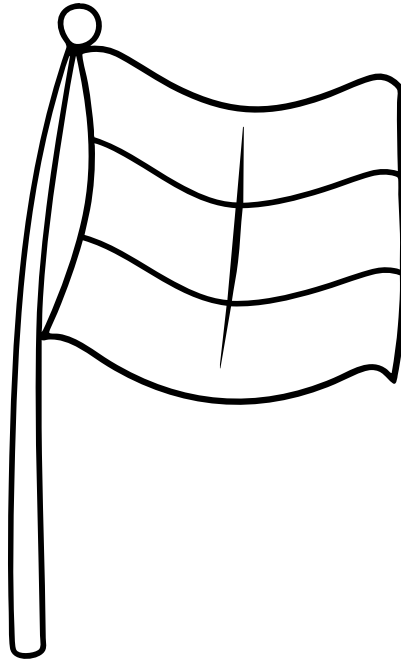




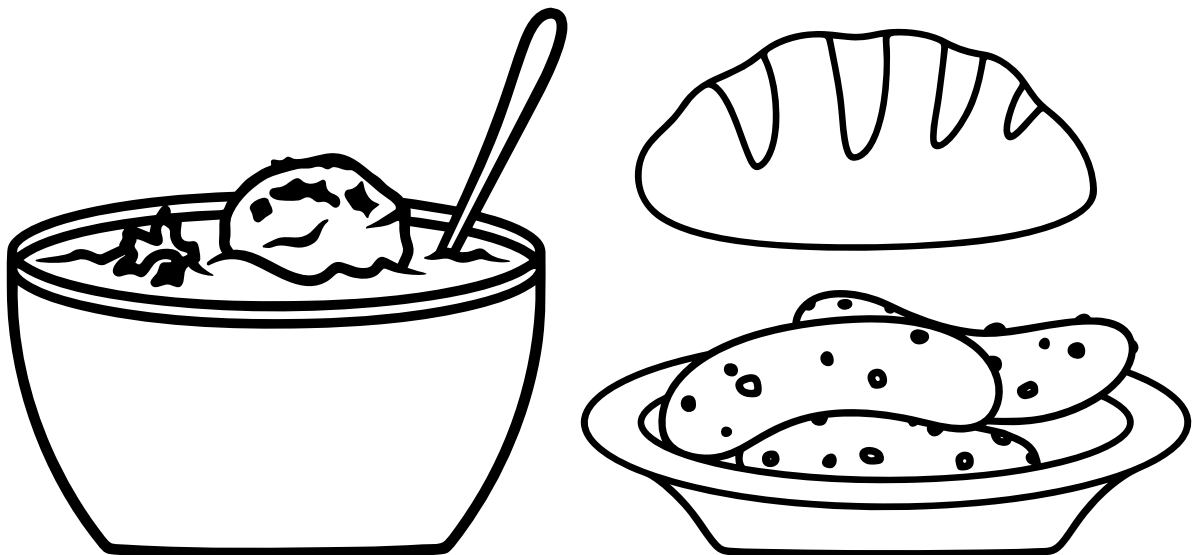

Russia is the largest country in the world. It spans across Europe and Asia, covering 11 time zones!



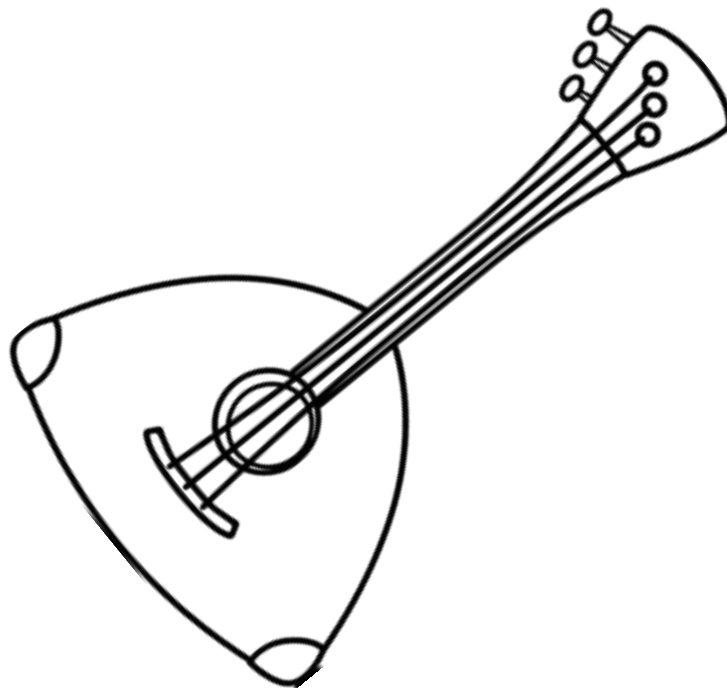
The Russian flag has three horizontal stripes of white, blue, and red. It was first used as a national flag in 1696.



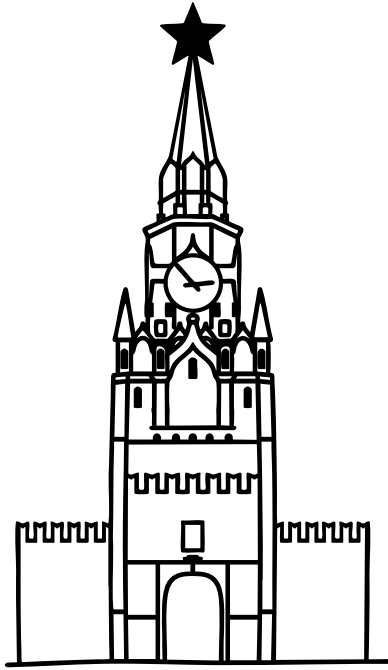
Russia is known for dishes like borscht (beet soup), pelmeni (dumplings), and black bread.



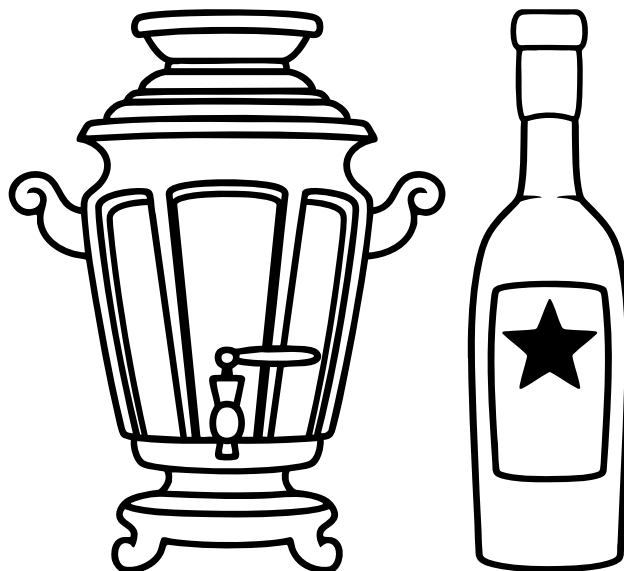
The famous Matryoshka dolls (nesting dolls) are a symbol of Russian art and culture.



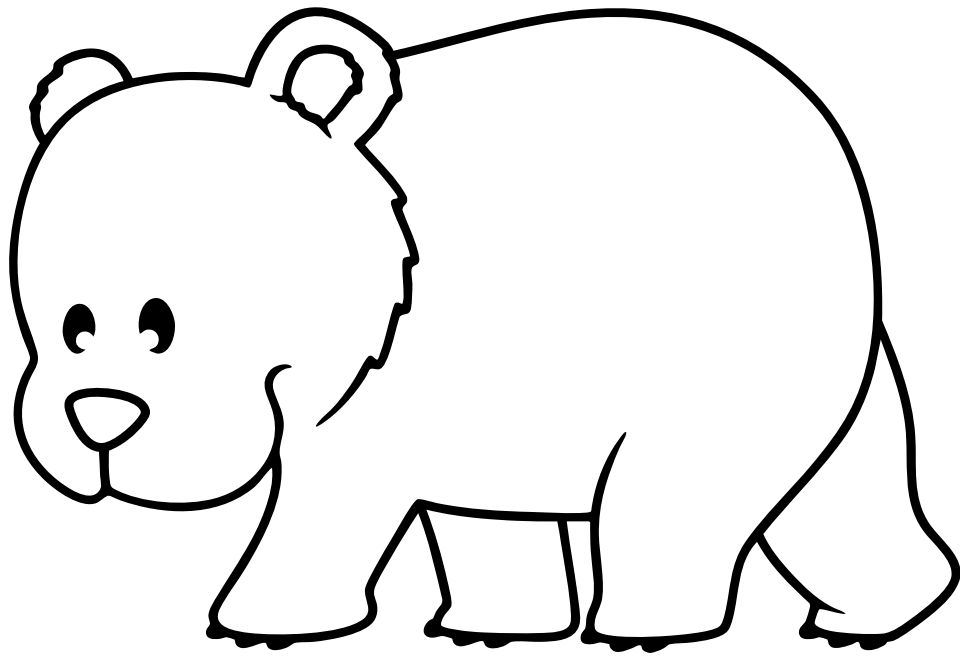
Russian music includes rich traditions of folk songs and dances, as well as classical composers like Tchaikovsky.
